

#### Village Kids Learn the Wonders of Music

Forte Music School is well known in the Toledo and surrounding areas as a top-notch school for learning music. With over 45 instructors teaching a wide range of instruments, vocals and musical styles, there is something for everyone. In addition, the school provides lessons without hidden fees or recital costs. All students are a top priority, regardless of age, so safety and convenience are very important. Time slots for lessons, Covid safety measures, background checks on all faculty and staff, video and audio surveillance, as well as observation windows allow students and parents to feel safe and comfortable.

Director Virgil Lupu, who grew up in a musical family in Transylvania, never thought he would end up the director of a private music school. He began playing the violin at age 7, went to a music oriented high school, and made his first trip to the US in 1998 when he had the opportunity to travel with a Romanian Traditional Folk Music and Dance youth group. "During that tour, we were placed with host families, which was a great way to learn more about the US culture, practice my English, and create great friendships." Virgil ended up at BGSU on a full music scholarship where he got his undergraduate degree in Violin Performance, then obtained his MA at the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music.

With the expansion of the school this past year and the ability to take on more students, Lupu wanted to extend the age range to include preschoolers. "The Music FunTime program that we started is meant to start music education from a very early age, where music will become part of their life, and hopefully students will continue their musical journey for many years and become a regular part of their life." Lupu and his staff, Ksenilia Stoian, the Music FunTime coordinator, and Ms. Chelsea Guadarrama, Music FunTime teacher (also teaches voice and piano), selected the Music FunTime program for its ability to incorporate a very hands-on approach, while teaching the basics of rhythm, reading music and playing music with others. Director Lupu said in a November 2021 press release, "I myself went through a similar program growing up in Romania, and when I found the Music FunTime system, I immediately recognized the value and decided right away to implement it here in Toledo."

The Music FunTime program is designed to last around 2 years, but children can take longer or move ahead faster. Children can join at any time as it is a year-round program. The children are assigned a group class by ages, 18mos to 3, 3 to 5 and 5 to 7 years of age. The tuition includes several musical instruments the kids can take home to practice with.

Carter Newell (Kindergarten), whose mom and dad both graduated from Ottawa Hills and live in the Village, loves guitar, but now is being exposed to all sorts of musical instruments, and loves it. Virginia Kozy (Pre-K) is just starting, but mom, Jessica, who is a Social Studies teacher and girls soccer coach at Ottawa Hills High School, said she was very excited to start the program. Edward Song, (Pre-K) has a fondness for drums, and Nia Ball (Pre-K) loves the piano and singing.

Director Lupu is happy to live in an area that has treated him so well, and with such a thriving arts community including major artistic entities such as the Toledo Museum of Art, The Toledo Symphony, and The Toledo Opera. He is excited about the new program at the school and what the future holds. "We are constantly trying to improve and keep up with the changes of our time. We constantly think of what we could do to improve the overall customer experience,





We teach your child to read music in the same manner they are taught letters, numbers, colors, shapes, etc. We have created an array of colorful music teaching tools and worksheets that teach rhythm, pitch, notation, symbols and key signatures.

Rebecca graduated from Seoul National University in Seoul, Korea with a Bachelor's degree in Viola performance. She was awarded as one of the 15% young talented players in the Seoul Philharmonic Orchestra with monthly salarv compensation. She also taught as an adjunct instructor in Mok-Won and **Kang-Reung** universities in Korea. Rebecca studied at The Ohio State University with **Professor** Martin Kelly for a Master's degree in viola performance.

She also studied a second master's in string pedagogy at Ohio University until she married. Her professor Mr. Howard Bebee invited her to join the Athens Trio as a violist whenever the three professors performed piano quartets.

Rebecca played in the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra as a section violist until her fourth child was born, at which point she decided to stay home and raise her children. After 3 years, she resumed her teaching and orchestra playing in the St. John's high school orchestra, Toledo Christian Schools, Great Lakes Symphony Orchestra, and Livonia Symphony Orchestras. Now she is a Music Appreciation & Chorus music teacher for 9th-12th in Toledo Public Virtual School.

She remains a certified Suzuki teacher, raising section principles and concert competition winners in the Toledo Youth Orchestras, for the past forty+ years of teaching. Rebecca shares her joy of teaching when a student desires and understands how to improve violin & viola playing, and helps them achieve high goals through meticulous practice.

Tyler is a second-year master's student at Bowling Green State University working towards his Master of Music in violin performance. He was appointed teaching graduate assistantship upon acceptance and now works closely with Dr. Elaine Colprit in the String Methods undergraduate course. He currently studies under the tutelage of Dr. Penny Thompson-Kruse (Professor of Violin at **Bowling Green State University).** His previous teachers include Daniel Mason (Professor Violin at the University Kentucky),

Ms. Lauren Wright, and Mr. Aaron Breeck. Tyler has also performed in masterclasses taught by Jeffrey Multer (Concertmaster of the Florida Symphony Orchestra), Dr. Laura Kobayashi (student of string pedagogue Dorothy DeLay), Dr. Solomia Soroka (Professor of Violin at Goshen College), Miro Hristov (Professor of Violin at the University of Tennessee), and Daniel Mason (Professor of Violin at the University of Kentucky).

A native of Kentucky, Tyler holds a Bachelor of Music in Music Performance with a minor in Psychology from the University of Kentucky. He has taught alongside student teachers and faculty in the University of Kentucky Strings Project, engaged in teaching and audition workshops with the Central Kentucky Youth Orchestras, and has been a local private teacher in the Lexington-Fayette area since 2016. He currently holds an online teaching position as Violin/Viola Instructor with the Central Music Academy in Lexington, KY. This past year, Tyler also worked with and mentored students in the Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestras as part of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra Civic Youth Ensembles Mentor Program.
