Forté Music School Expands Facility and Adds Toddler Programming

hen the pandemic hit, Forté music school had many families pulling their kids from music lessons after devastating job losses. It wasn't easy to weather the storm, but Forté has persevered and adapted to the "new normal" by adding air purifiers, a top-notch HVAC system complete with UV lights, while adhering to all recommended safety precautions.

"Thankfully, most of our wonderful students understood and were there for us!" says the school's director, Virgil Lupu. "We were able to keep going through online lessons, and slowly we were able to rebuild back to where we were two years ago."

Forté has now expanded to create studios on the second floor of their building, including eight new studio spaces to accommodate more than 700 students and 43 professionally trained music instructors. This expansion was an incredible feat during the pandemic, when contractors were not easy to come by.

To add to this accomplishment, Forté has also incorporated Music FunTime classes into their programming, which are ideal for children aged two through five. Though it is designed to last two years, kids can take their time, learning at their own pace. A curriculum derived from research at Johns-Hopkins, Music FunTime enables kids to get a head start on their foundational knowledge of music.

"Kids absolutely love these classes!" says Lupu. "Seeing their smiles every time they come to class and every time they get a new instrument is priceless. It pays off for all the struggles we had to overcome during the expansion and during the launch of this new program."

Julia – Piano & Voice



FORTÉ MUSIC SCHOOL'S EXPANSION!

Forté Music School in Toledo, the largest private music school in the area, serving the community for over 15 years, is now proud to announce the opening of their second-floor location by adding eight more spacious studios. Forté Music School is now the happy home of over 700 students and families and 43 teachers in a beautiful space of over 6,000 square feet and 22 spacious studios.

Many music schools around the country have been forced to close their doors or suspend classes altogether until further notice, but Forté Music School fights to go in the opposite direction. Over the past two years, Forté Music School director Virgil Lupu has been working tirelessly to expand the school to the second floor and add eight more spacious studios.

"I never thought it would take us this long. It was not easy to find contractors to get the job done

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during a pandemic! Mostly everything was on backorder, overpriced, delayed, or postponed, but we somehow pulled through.

"When everything shut down, we lost over 100 students in 30 days due to several families losing their jobs. It was tragic! Luckily, we had a lot of support from the community who understood that if they do not stick

with us during this time, we might not make it out of the pandemic! Thankfully, most of our wonderful students understood and were there for us! We were able to keep going through online lessons, and slowly we were able to rebuild back to where we were two years ago. We slowly transitioned back to in-person lessons, but it was not easy. When we reopened, we went far and beyond to ensure the safety of our teachers, students, and parents. We have a lot of safety measures in place. Of course, we instituted the normal temperature checks, hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, masks, social distancing, limited occupancy for the waiting area, etc., but we went a step even further, installing UV lights in our HVAC systems and placing MARV 13 air filters in the HVAC system and extra air purifiers in our waiting areas."

Virgil Lupu is very thankful to live in an area that is surrounded by art institutions such as the wonderful Art Museum, the Symphony Orchestra, the Opera, several dance companies, art galleries, etc. Art and education in general are so important, particularly these days when children are constantly surrounded by distractions. Music education has a particularly major impact on the development of the brain, which cannot be replaced by other activities.

"Despite all our efforts to provide quality service, we could not have survived without the help of our clients, and I must say, I am very proud of our community for understanding the value of music education! This expansion is our way to give back to the community by creating extra space and breathing room, and to show appreciation for being there for us, particularly over the past two years! We promise to continue to constantly improve and provide the highest level of private music education."

Director Virgil Lupu is an accomplished violinist who started his





musical journey at age 5 with a similar early music program and started playing the violin at age 7. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Violin Performance from BGSU and a Master's degree in Violin Performance from the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, earning both degrees while on a full talent-based scholarship.

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discover a love for music through quality and affordable lessons for all levels of musicianship. Lessons are offered on voice, piano, percussion, strings, woodwinds, and brass instruments.
